# BLANDING TRANSFER STATION

**Charges:**

A city resident who is paying a Blanding solid waste charge may bring a City utility bill to the dump station to verify they are a City Resident. The person doing the dumping must be the person who is listed on the utility bill or a recognizable immediate family member.

## WASTE MANAGEMENT INFO

Blanding City helps facilitate weekly trash removal from residential and commercial locations. We do not own or operate Waste Management. Waste Management has asked that you place your trash can (tote) out the night before or by 7:00 am at the latest if you wish for your trash to be picked up and removed each week. Please do not stack bags on top of the trash can or leave piles of trash next to the cans. They will not be picked up.
